When the Church is Silent



I have been thinking a lot today about the topics that we as church choose talk about and what we seem to avoid.

It strikes me that the church at times talks a lot about issues of personal morality. Sexuality for instance is an issue that most Churches have no problem in preaching about, confronting individuals (and the world) on and defining what is right and wrong in.

However there seem to be a number of other issues that often get left out. Consumerism, Individualism, Elitism and Materialism (to name a few) are issues that in my reading of the gospel that Jesus had things to say about. They are also things that permeate our culture in the West yet which we tend to sweep under the carpet.

Just last week I heard of a church attendee who was asked not to come back to their church of 9 years because their struggle with their homosexuality had become public. The leadership of this church was quick to act on this issue - in their eyes it was a clear cut call and they felt compelled to confront. I've heard similar such tales on numerous occasions in the past few years.

However I'm yet to hear of a church where the leadership confronted an individual member on the way they spend their money. I'm yet to hear a tale where someone was asked to leave a church because in their job they made decisions which exploited or oppressed the poor. I've never heard of a church sitting down a member out of a concern for their workaholic tendencies.

Why do some parts of our life seem to be impacted by faith while others are kept separate? Why are some 'compartments' of ones life open to the church's scrutiny and comment while others are largely ignored?

It was like walking through a door into another time (the donkeys have the right of way as they are the only way of transport - watch out for them...and for where you step). All through the shops selling everything from fish and meat through to spices, ceramics and woven materials.

In the very centre of the Souk is a beautiful Mosque where everyone descends rhythmically throughout the day. The streets outside the Souk are filled with people, many of whom are blind or sitting with children pleading for a few cents.



Strangely enough I came out of the Souk feeling similar to just seen Matrix. Wierd I know - but after two hours of intense numbness yet also completely exhilarated after catching a glimpse I've been living in to that point.

Fes was a definite highlight of the trip.



A new breed of cameras

CNET has an interesting article on the latest developments in digital camera chips.

'Digital photography could become one of the next big opportunities for the chip industry, at least according to companies that want to bring PC-style economics to the camera industry. Their goal: Become the Intel, or at least the Advanced Micro Devices, of photography.'

"We're fighting the processor wars all over again," said Gary Baum, senior vice president of NuCore Technology, which makes the CleanCapture image processors for video and still cameras from JVC, Kyocera and others. "Remember the mid-'80s? PCs cost \$5,000, and everybody made their own chipsets. Then the price wars hit."

The push into photography derives in part from its booming growth. Shipments of digital still cameras grew from 46.4 million in 2003 to 62 million in 2004--a 33.6 percent increase, according to industry researcher iSuppli. And phone makers will include multi-megapixel cameras and video features in the bulk of their models over the next two years.'

I think people work on the presumption that we all love in our photo.
